Please arrive 20 minutes before the scheduled dress rehearsal time to go over important auditorium procedures. Dancers must be in full costume with hair and makeup at dress rehearsal.

WE STILL NEED CLASS CHAPERONES!

CLASS CHAPERONE DUTIES:

- Meet and check-in the dancers before the show and help get the children back to their parents after the show. Each class will either have a reserved row inside the auditorium OR assigned to be in the overflow classroom. This is where parents will drop off and pick up their child.
- Be present for dress rehearsal to go over and practice recital day procedures.
- Lead the class backstage 4 numbers before their performance, hangout backstage while they perform, and then return the dancers to either their row of seats in the auditorium OR the overflow classroom.
- Make sure the dancers stay seated or in the overflow classroom during the time they are watching the show.

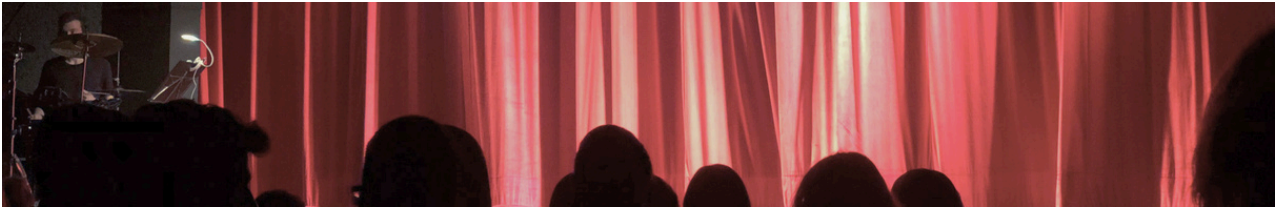

IMPORTANT RECITAL REMINDERS

THEATER ETIQUETTE

Looking ahead to recital, here are some important reminders for our audience members to help make it a great experience for both spectator and performer!



DON'T

Get up and move around during the show.

It is important to stay in your seat throughout the show. Moving around the theater is extremely distracting to other spectators AND performers. If you have to excuse yourself, do so quickly and quietly in between dances, NOT in the middle of a routine.



DON'T

Yell out your dancers name.

While we want you to clap and cheer, it can be distracting if a dancer hears someone calling their name or trying to wave at them.



DON'T

Be on your phone or let it ring during the show.

The cell phone light shining is distracting for both audience members and performers. Your phone must be silenced throughout the show.



DON'T

Take photos or videos during the show.

We strictly prohibit ALL photography and videography during our recital shows. This is extremely distracting! Our professional videographer will produce an amazing video for you.



DO

ARRIVE EARLY!

Our shows will start right on time. Please be in your seat at showtime, so you don't have to find your seat in the dark.



DO

CHEER & CLAP LOUDLY!

The performers feed off the audiences energy!



DO

DRESS UP!

This is a special occasion for your dancer! Looking your best is highly recommended.

ENJOY THE SHOW!

These kids have worked so hard this year. Let's cheer them on!
